Directions to the Towson University Union Building from the Baltimore Beltway (I-695):

Take I-695 toward Towson. Take Exit 25, Charles St. south. Proceed approximately 1.7 miles. Turn left on Towsontown Blvd. and proceed to the first stoplight. Turn right on Osler Dr. and take the first left at the light. Proceed to the University Union parking garage. Weekend parking is free. Park on the lower level and follow the signs to the University Union.
